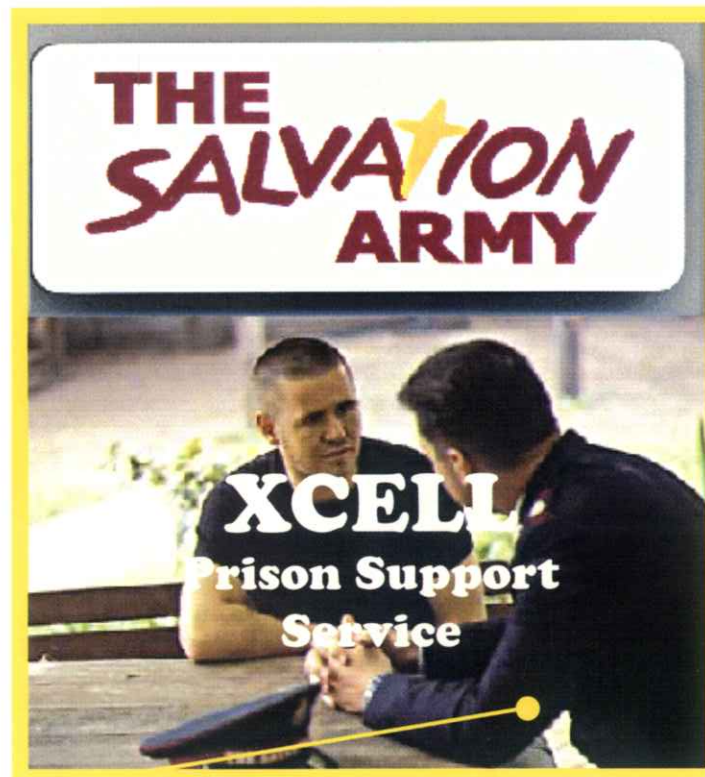

You've done your time

After being released, many ex-prisoners find it difficult to reintegrate into society. Barriers to successful re-integration include homelessness, unemployment and a general lack of family and community support.



The key to your future

XCELL is a Salvation Army Service dedicated to providing practical assistance and support to prisoners pre and post release by:

- Working with prisoners 6-8 weeks pre-release to prepare a Release plan
- Offering counselling and support pre and post release
- Advocating on behalf of prisoners and ex-prisoners
- Providing information and referrals as appropriate

Pre-Release Support

We can help prisoners prepare for release by considering with them the challenges freedom will bring. For example, we can work with prisoners and also refer them to agencies to assist with issues such as finding accommodation, reconnecting with family and friends, seeking employment, alcohol, drug and gambling counselling and rehabilitation, literacy issues and financial counselling.

Post-Release Support

Adjusting from prison life to life outside is a difficult process and issues can confront prisoners that they would least expect. For example, crossing a busy street or having to make decisions again can be overwhelming. We can provide practical on-going support and counselling to assist with these adjustments.
